This year St Andrew's day also marks the start of the annual Caledoniart Christmas Art Exhibition and London's Scots will start to celebrate Christmas a little early. Opposite the plaque commemorating the death of William Wallace, Smithfield Gallery is the perfect home to this exhibition.

Caledoniart Christmas 2009 includes art from more than 20 of Scotland's finest contemporary artists including John Lowrie Morrison ('Jolomo'), Peter Howson, John Bellany, Erni Upton, George Birrell, Catriona Campbell, Tim Cockburn and Anthony Scullion along with emerging talent like Jamie Hageman, Georgina McMaster, Ryan Hanigan, and Lesley Anne Derks.

The list reads as a Who's Who of the Scottish art scene and includes Scottish landscape, figurative, animal and botanical paintings in many mediums and sculpture from Mhairi Corr and Walter Awlson.

Caledoniart is a Scottish owned, London based, family company representing some of Scotland's best living artists and holds 3 exhibitions of Scottish art each year in London. In 2010 includes 'Jolomo' one man exhibition in May and 'Jolomo Landscape Prize 2009 Finalists', in October.
